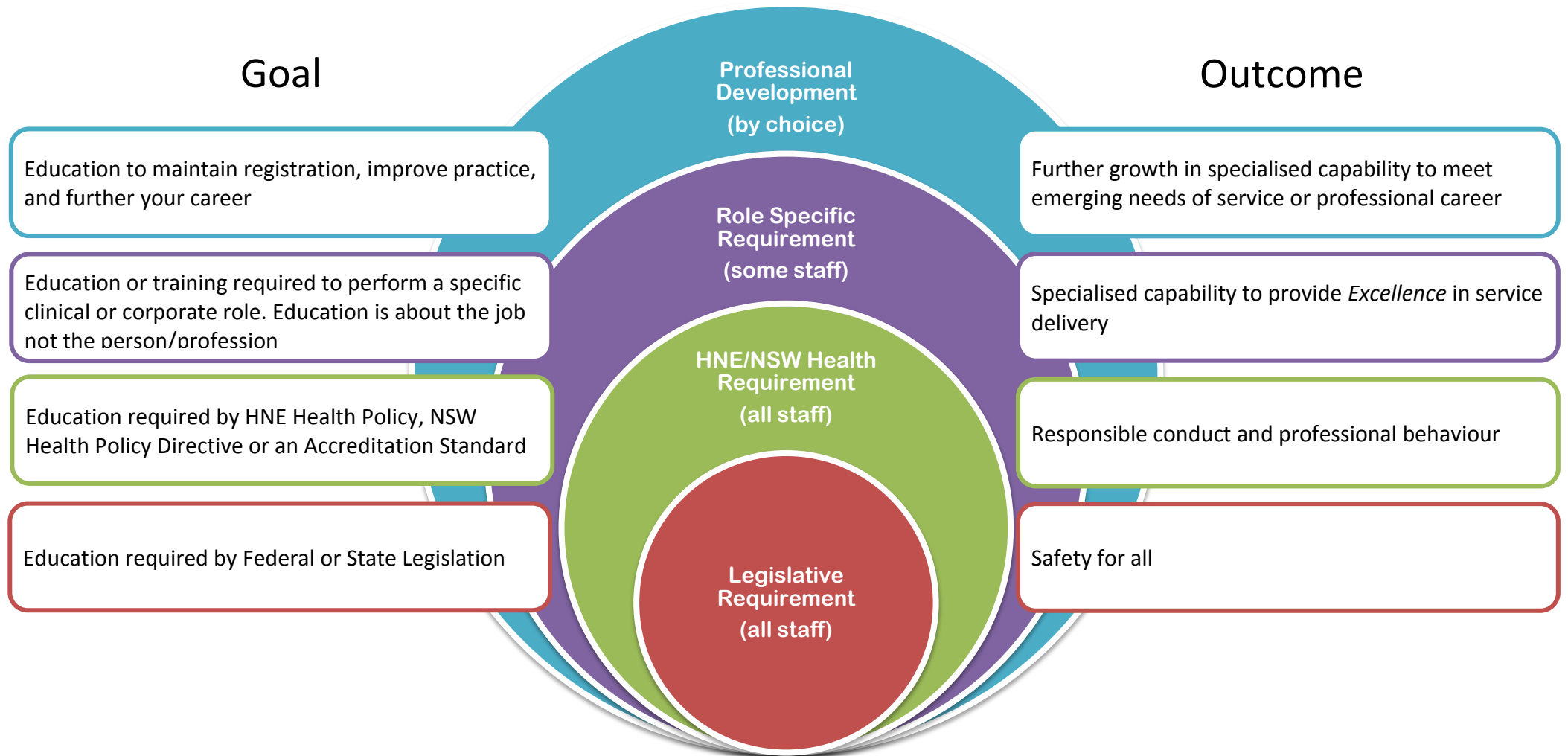


# Hunter New England Health Required Education
